



North Dakota's Women 2016

Violence and Safety

Recently North Dakota Compass, Center for Social Research at North Dakota State University, conducted a statistical overview on the situation of women in North Dakota. Here are a few of the findings.

- » Women represent over 90% of victims of sexual assault, while men represent at least 95% of assailants.
- » Women represent 93% of the 5,356 new victims of domestic violence in North Dakota (2015).
- » The number of primary sexual assault victims is rising in North Dakota, a 22.5% increase from 2007 to 2015.
- » Female students in North Dakota are more likely than males to be bullied on school property and to be bullied electronically.
- » 9.6% of female high school students in North Dakota have experienced physical dating violence.
- » 9.8% of female high school students in North Dakota have been physically forced to have sexual intercourse.
